## **New Book Offers Construction Industry a Convenient Two-in-One Resource**

- Transporting, disposing, storing, containing, and housekeeping asbestos or asbestos-containing products on site

Part two of the book examines OSHA's lead standard for the construction industry, 29 CFR Part 1926.62. This portion of the book covers lead in a variety of forms, including metallic lead, all inorganic lead compounds, and organic lead soaps.
